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Fiber Workshop Festival

One-Day Dye Workshops For Weavers & Knitters

Hand Paint / Dye 1 lb. of Wool Yarn

Use chemical dyes and set the dyes in the microwave.

Hand Paint / Dye Silk Ribbon

Dye 90 yds. habotai silk ribbon and set the dyes in the microwave

Embellishing Fiber

Create a textured fabric from silk scraps and free motion embroidery. Then turn it into a purse and embellish it with beads etc. Bring beads, ribbon, and trim scraps. If you wish, bring a sewing machine with a free motion embroidery foot. There will be machines available at the workshop.

Mood Indigo Week

Indigo is an ancient natural blue dye, and a special kind of vat dye. The color develops when the fiber is exposed to the air. Each dip deepens the blue color of the fiber.

Tee-Shirt Indigo Dyeing For The Family

Dip once, twice as many times as you want. 20 minutes per dip in vat.

Indigo Dye Wool Yarn

Dip as many times as you want.

Indigo Shibori Technique on Silk

Pleat, fold, twist, wrap and use string to resist the dye on silk.

- Friday, July 8; 1-4 p.m.

Indigo on Cotton Scarf/Table Runner

Dip a hand-woven scarf.

4 natural dye pots. (Cochineal, Osage Orange, Madder, Logwood)
