Hand Paint/Dye 1 lb. of Wool Yarn (1-Day Workshop)

If possible, bring a sewing machine with a free motion embroidery foot.

MOOD INDIGO DAYS **Indigo Instructor: Joann Condino**

Indigo is an ancient natural blue dye. The wonderful color of your blue jeans.

It is a special kind of vat dye. The color develops when the fiber is exposed to the air.

Batik Indigo Table Runner and/or Napkins

Design and dye your fabric combining the ancient arts of wax batik and indigo.

SILK PAINTING WORKSHOPS **Silk Instructor: Joann Condino**

Workshops can be customized to fit your needs. i.e. family groups, women's groups, birthday parties, etc.

Silk Painting (1-Day Workshop)

Students will explore the preparation of dyes and the application of resist and dyes to silk and then set the color using chemical mordants. Students will go home with a completed silk painting.

Advanced Silk Painting Techniques (1-Day Workshop)

ALTERED STATES WORKSHOPS **NEW**

Workshops in collage and assemblage in paper, fiber and wood.

Modern collage as an art form was born in 1910 when Picasso pasted a piece of newspaper on one of his drawings. When a collage is made with three-dimensional objects it becomes an assemblage or a construction. Collage is an art form that is not bound by conventional materials or formal technique. For the artist, a collage begins with a series of questions regarding textures, surfaces and color. Art lies in the selection and composition of the materials. The collage may tell a story, state a theme or evoke a memory.

Altered States Jacket of Many Colors (3-Day Workshop)

This workshop emphasis is not sewing, but creating with color and fiber. Using batik and other amazing fabrics you will alter a sweatshirt into a jacket. Transforming it into a vehicle to express your love of color and pattern. Some sewing skills necessary. Students will need a sewing machine (a limited number will be available) and a new or old sweatshirt (at least one size larger than you normally wear).
